Dependency, Addiction and Recovery Training (DART)

What is dependency and addiction? How big a factor does stigma and adverse childhood experiences play in an individual developing and sustaining addiction and dependency? And what is recovery? This one-day course is designed for attendees to gain a better understanding around the concepts of dependency and addiction of drugs and alcohol such as the role of our neurotransmitters when interacting with specific substances. The course also looks at what recovery is and how it can be achieved.

At the end of the course, attendee's will be able to:

- * Discuss a mixture of theories behind addiction and dependence
- * Analyse the factors that increase the risk of people developing addiction and dependency such as Adverse Childhood Experiences
- * Explain the various elements such as psychological and neurological factors that can affect addiction and dependence
- * Describe what is meant by recovery
- * Discuss whether an addictive personality exists

Fentanyl: A crisis or false dawn?

Media attention regarding the risks and harms posed by Fentanyl use, has continued to grow in the last couple of years. This half day course provides an overview of what the opioid is, puts various myths to bed and provides the landscape of its use within Wales and the UK.

At the end of the course, the attendee's will be able to:

- * Recall the latest statistics regarding drug related deaths in the UK
- * Discuss and share information regarding fentanyl
- * List the effects and risks of fentanyl use
- * Recall harm reduction advice regarding fentanyl use

Synthetic Cannabinoids: The problem child of NPS

Synthetic Cannabinoids, or Spice as many know it by, continues to be used across the country. This half day course allows the attendee's to gain an understanding around current trends in relation to New Psychoactive Substances (NPS) and specifically around Synthetic Cannabinoids.

At the end of the course, the attendee's will be able to:

- * Recall up-to-date information regarding NPS in Wales
- * List effects of use and potential withdrawal signs and symptoms in relation to Synthetic Cannabinoid dependency
- * Discuss ways to reduce the impact of NPS use
- * List harm reduction techniques to reduce the risks and harms posed by Synthetic Cannabinoid use

Opioids and Depressants: Pain or Pleasure?

Opioid-based drugs such as heroin and depressants like Valium get bad press, but is it deserved? This one-day course looks at a range of substances that come under these two categories. The attendee's will delve from the world of heroin production to opioid substitution treatment. The difference between pregabalin and gabapentin will be explored as well as the effects and risks posed by Valium derivatives that are available within the market.

At the end of the course, the attendees will be able to:

- * Recall the latest statistics in relation to opiate and depressant drug use
- * Explore own attitudes towards opiate and depressant drug use including substitute prescribing
- * Identify the effects, risks and harms associated with opiate and depressant drug use including heroin and diazepam
- * Discuss the role of substitute prescribing and pharmacological treatment within an individual's recovery journey
- * Recall the implications of misuse and diversion within recovery
