Naloxone Click & Deliver



On the 30th November, Barod launched Wales' first Naloxone Click and Deliver Service. This enables anyone in Wales to gain access to the life-saving medication and have it delivered to their door, for free.

Caroline said "Naloxone is a life-saving intervention and the more ways people can gain access to it, the better. Our learning from Covid-19 has enabled us to broaden and innovate our services."

"This can only be good for those affected by substance use, including loved ones and our communities"

Caroline added, "We have increased our digital services over the last 18-months, and this new naloxone Click and Deliver offers an additional way for people to get hold of the life-saving drug."

Alcohol Awareness Week

15th - 19th November

Throughout the week, many services raised awareness of alcohol and harm reduction by informing the public in their local areas.

The Cwm Taf team visited multiple areas including Tesco in Merthyr, Asda in Aberdare, University of South Wales and Merthyr Valleys Youth Project.







Police carrying Naloxone



Barod initiated the first discussions with South Wales Police just over 2 years ago to highlight the role the first response from police can play in responding to an opiate overdose.

"There are now 50 volunteer officers who are now carrying Naloxone"

If they can save the life of one person, it will allow the officers to refer them to Barod, and our partners, for treatment and intervention, with the aim of preventing further such incidents and giving the person a chance to make a choice. Watch the launch of this pilot <u>here</u>.

DDAS and Choices West have also been training police officers in overdose awareness and naloxone, with Dyfed Powys Police set to start carrying the life-saving medication.



Research

Swansea has been identified as one of the areas to take part in the international NalPORS study, led by King's College, London.

By recruiting 6,000 participants, this study aims to assess the effectiveness of takehome naloxone (THN) to reverse opioid overdose when administered by lay persons in a real world setting.



If you are based in Swansea and work with someone who has been supplied naloxone, or has witnessed an overdose, they could help with this significant research.

WINTER FUEL SUPPORT

This is separate from the Warm Home Discount. Eligible households will be able to claim a one-off £100 cash payment. It will be available to all eligible energy customers regardless of whether they pay for their fuel on a pre-payment or a credit meter.

Eligibility

The scheme is open to households where one member is in receipt of certain welfare benefit.

A member of the household must have been claiming these benefits at any time between 1 December 2021 and 31 January 2022.

- Income Support
- Income Based Job Seekers Allowance
- Income Based Employment and Support Allowance
- Universal Credit
- Working Tax Credits

This fund is being administered by local authorities in Wales. Households should be directed towards their local authority for more information. Payments will be made from 13 December 2021 until 31 March 2022. 
Mike Parry Art Award Vote
