Terms and conditions

- The competition is open to all individuals who have accessed substance use services in Wales, either past or present.
- Only one entry per individual, or one entry per group.
- All entries will be placed into one of three categories: Young People; Adult; and Group.
- Entries can be submitted in any art form.
- Each entry must be the original work of the artist.
- Entries must be a representation of the topic "SOLIDARITY".
- All entries must be received by midnight on 29th December 2023. Any entries after this date will not be considered and will not count.
- Entry forms must be submitted with a photograph of the piece, with the piece being transported to the exhibition venue when that time arises.
- All entries must have an accompanying narrative alongside a photograph of the piece. The narrative will form part of the scoring.
- The competition will be judged by a panel and the panel's decision will be final.
- Barod cannot take any responsibility for any damage to artwork as a result of submitting the artwork for exhibition, either in transport or storage.
- In the event of the winning entry not being contactable, after reasonable attempts have been made, we reserve the right to offer the prize to a runner up, but are not obliged to do so.
- By entering this competition, you are confirming that you are happy for Barod to use pictures of your artwork for promotional purposes.
 This can be done without using your name / full name if preferred.
- Barod will not use your contact information for any other purpose that contacting you regarding the award.
- Applicants are deemed to agree with these terms and conditions if they are entering the competition.
