

Trauma and Ace (TrACE) Informed Practice Steering Group


As you heard at the Barod development day we now have a well-established Trauma and Ace (TrACE) Informed Practice Steering Group within Barod. The group meets quarterly, to work through the TrACE action plan which is aligned to the Trauma Informed Wales Framework and the ACE's hub self-assessment tool kit.

Our current priority pieces of work include:

- Raising the profile of TrACE informed practice and increasing levels of understanding across the organisation.
- Piloting a Barod environment audit tool across all Barod services and developing improvement plans.
- Embedding the ACE's hub policy guidance document into all policy reviews.
- Developing a resources library to share with staff.
- Incorporating TrACE informed practice into Barod's recruitment process review.
- Rolling out the ACE's hub e-learning training to all staff.


